## QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE HIRING A HOME INSPECTOR

- 1. Is the inspector a licensed builder? Please verify the builder is licensed at: <a href="https://www2.dleg.state.mi.us/colaLicVerify">https://www2.dleg.state.mi.us/colaLicVerify</a> THIS IS IMPORTANT: The state can only offer protection towards consumer only if inspector is licensed through the state. (State of Michigan has no licensing requirements for home inspectors) The truth is, anyone can legally inspect your home in the state of Michigan!
- 2. Is the inspector a member of a certified organization? Check with (NACHI)

  <a href="http://www.nachi.org">http://www.nachi.org</a> (Other organizations are simply fee paid void of mandated testing and continuing education)
- **3. Is the inspector certified in foundations?** *This is the most important feature of a dwelling.* Ask inspector the difference between a vertical, horizontal or diagonal foundation wall crack.
- 4. Is the inspector certified in code requirements, minimum property standards and safety issues? All home inspectors should be certified for the safety and benefit of the consumer.
- 5. **Is the inspector a member of BBB?** (Better Business Bureau) **All home inspectors should be listed with the BBB for consumer protection!** Do a google search under BBB. (Qualified home inspectors should have an A+ rating)
- **6. Does the inspector have a web site?** *This helps identify (not guarantee) to consumer's inspector holds himself out to the world as a home inspector.*
- 7. Is the inspector licensed through HUD/FHA/VA and is his company recognized with lending institutions? *Verification can be found at:* <a href="https://entp.hud.gov/idapp/html/insplook.cfm">https://entp.hud.gov/idapp/html/insplook.cfm</a>
- **8. Does the inspector do home inspections full time and how long in business?** *Part time home inspectors should never be hired or trusted to perform any home inspection.*
- **9. What credentials warrant the inspector to perform home inspections? Example:** *Does inspector or did inspector write for a newspaper or publish articles regarding the home inspection or housing industry?*

Homebuyer's should ask these (9) paramount questions prior to hiring a person to inspect the home you and your family intend to occupy.
